Historical Perspective:

The ERR plan included \$25,000 for a new Parks mower and \$325,000 for the Dump Truck replacement with plow and sand/salt spreader. The dump truck and plow have been ordered, but the spreader needs to be ordered separately.

Information for Consideration:

The ERR plan which was previously approved by Council included both these items. The spreader will have saddle tanks and a pre-wet system so materials can be pre-treated as they are applied for snow/ice control.

The Police vehicles will be purchased for \$9,000 plus tax each and will serve as replacement backup vehicles for the Police Department. Four older model backup police vehicles will be sold.

Historical Perspective:

This past winter there was a significant water line that broke under Ivy lane. City crews made repairs, but very quickly realized how much of the road had been undermined. Crews made repairs to the damaged road base which left roughly 150 feet of Ivy lane without much asphalt. Crews have since gone in and replaced more water services in preparation for the area to be restored and repaved.

Information for Consideration:

This is the low bid for work to repair the base and rebuild the asphalt for the damaged section of Ivy Lane. Without these repairs this section of the road will remain unpaved.

Public Content

Historical Perspective:

The City hired RH2 to design Well 7 (now referred to as Well 8). The City hired Gregory drilling to drill the well, but they lacked the speciality well development expertise needed to complete the job. The City then authorized RH2 to subcontract well development services to Holt Industries. Holt completed the initial scope of work raising the well yields from roughly 150 gpm to roughly 500 gpm. Holt and RH2 think they can conduct further development which could raise yields to 700 gpm or higher.

Information for Consideration:

Even with this amendment, the well drilling costs will still be less than the intitial contract previously authorized with Gregory Drilling. RH2 plans to oversee Holt as a sub to them with no markup.

This well is critical City infrastructure and ideally needs to be able to produce 700gpm or higher.

Mayor Hernández delivered the Public Works Week Proclamation and gave the signed certificate to Public Works Director Robert McAndrews.

Discussion: 3.02 AB 25123 - Lions Park Project Funding - Mr. Carleton

Mr. Carleton informed the Council that, as December 2024 financials were being reviewed, he realized that there was a shortfall in the budget due to the City not being reimbursed for grant awards yet in the same amount. The City utilizes a cash basis budget process which dictates that the fund must not be negative at the end of the year. Current Expense did not have enough fund balance in it to move the funds without going below the mandatory savings threshold and therefore an interfund loan process and procedure must be developed to satisfy the budget needs.

Discussion ensued.

5. Action Items.

Action: 5.01 AB 25124 - SE 8th St Design - Mr. McAndrews

Mr. McAndrews informed the Council that sidewalks and widening SE 8th Street design is in its third phase of work which addresses the project from Elm to Larch. The project from Birch to College Ave is federally funded while the rest is TIB funded. The project is not fully funded and this amendment is for design only.

Council Member Cleveland made a motion to authorize the Public Works Director or designee to sign contract Amendment #2 with J-U-B Engineers increasing the SE 8th Street sidewalk - SE Birch Ave to SE Larch design costs by \$41,500. Second by Council Member Williams and the motion passed 6-0.

Action: 5.02 AB 25125 - Final Parks Plan - Mr. Rickard

Mr. Rickard presented the final 2025 Parks, Open Space, and Recreation Plan to Council.

Council Member Williams made a motion to authorize Resolution # 25-032 which acknowledges the 2025 Parks, Open Space, and Recreation Plan as an official guiding document for the City of College Place. Second by Council Member Schermann and the motion passed 6-0.

Action: 5.03 AB 25126 - Diligent Community Implementation - Ms. Garcia

Ms. Garcia reviewed with Council the Diligent Community migration proposal and confirmed the annual price includes the cost of the migration.

Council Member Jessup made a motion to adopt Resolution # 25-033 which authorizes the City Administrator to sign the contract with Diligent to replace the BoardDocs software with Diligent Community. Second by Council Member Peterson and the motion passed 6-0.

Action: 5.04 AB 25127 - Sister City Committee with Jungapeo, Mexico - Ms. Garcia & Mr. Everett

Ms. Garcia reviewed with the Council the Youth Advisory Commission's initiative to create a Sister City relationship with Jungapeo, Mexico. Due to Jungapeo's Adventist population, Monarch Butterfly origination site, and agricultural lifestyle, it was deemed a fitting Sister City for College Place. Mayor Hernández presented a signed copy of the Sister City Agreement to Mr. Hernandez.

Discussion ensued.

Council Member Espinoza made a motion to authorize Resolution # 25-034 which formally adopts, on behalf of College Place, Jungapeo, Michoacan, Mexico as the Sister City of the City of College Place and allows the Mayor to sign any further documents ratifying the official Sister City relationship. Second by Council Member Schermann and the motion passed 6-0.

Action: 5.05 AB 25128 - Fire Station Renovation ESCO Work - Mr. Rizzitiello

Mr. Rizzitiello reviewed with Council the Fire Station Renovation ESCO project which focuses on changing out electrical and HVAC systems within the station.

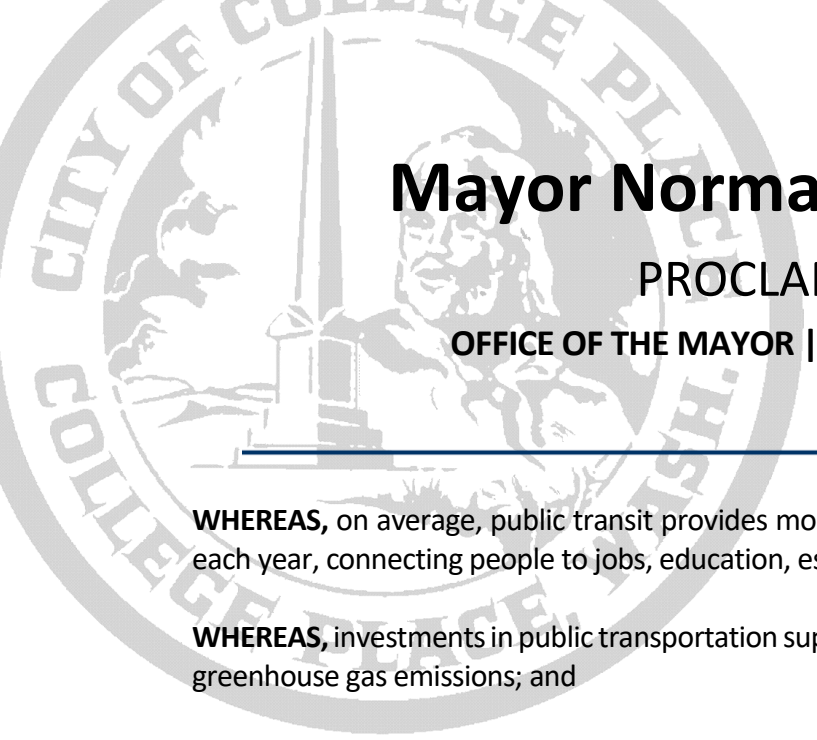

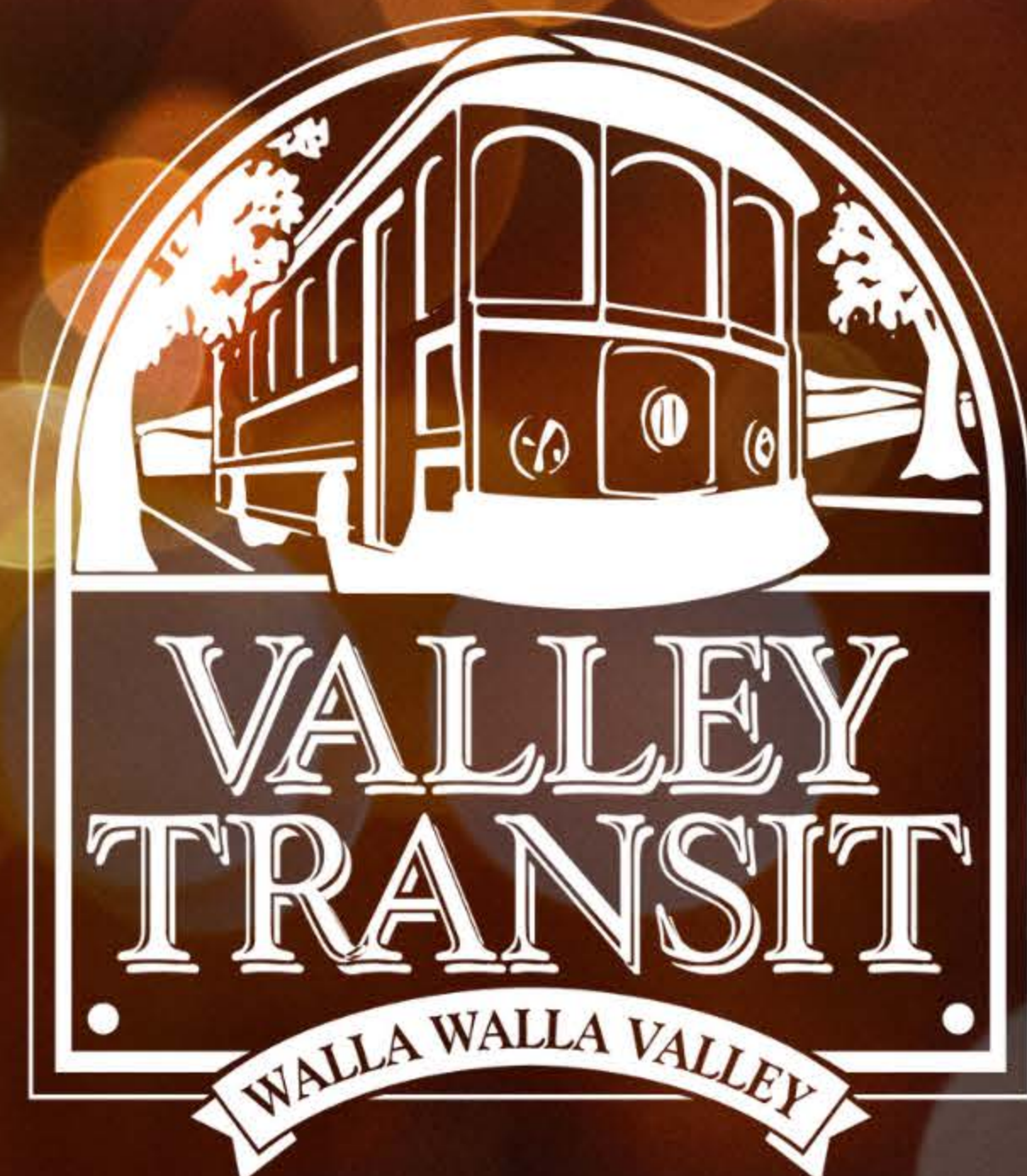

El Grupo de Trabajo se reunirá con la periodicidad y en el lugar que acuerden las Partes, a fin de evaluar los aspectos derivados de la aplicación del presente Acuerdo y tendrá a su cargo las funciones siguientes:

- a) adoptar las decisiones necesarias, a fin de cumplir con el objetivo del presente Acuerdo;

ARTICULO XII Solución de Controversias

(country); hereinafter referred to as “the Parties”;

CONSIDERING their interest to strengthen the friendship ties and cooperation that
join both Parties;

ACKNOWLEDGING that the cities have the intention to develop collaborative
activities, under the law provisions of the _____ (country of origin of the foreign
city) and the United Mexican States, with particular attention to the terms related to
business exchange, commerce, culture and craftsmanship;

DECLARING their decision to strengthen their relationship of collaboration through
the proper legal channels;

CONVINCED of the importance of establishing mechanisms that contribute to the
development and strengthening of bilateral cooperation, as well as the necessity to
execute projects and actions that are effective in the commercial and social development
of both Parties;

Have agreed to the following:

ARTICLE I

Objective

The objective of the present Agreement is to formalize the sisterhood between the City of _____ from the State of _____ of the United Mexican States and the City of _____ from the State of _____ of the _____ (*country*), to foster agreement and understanding between them and the institutions in their respective territorial areas, to intensify common efforts, and to promote the exchange of experiences and execution of common activities.

ARTICLE II

Areas of Cooperation

To reach the objective of the present Agreement, the Parties commit themselves to develop cooperative projects, specifically directed, but not limited to the following areas:

- a) Promotion of business, investments and commerce...
- b) Promotion of culture...
- c) Promotion of Tourism...
- d) Government development (human resources improvement)...
- e) Education...
- f) Science and technology...
- g) Environment...
- h) any other area of cooperation that the Parties may agree upon.

ARTICLE III

Modalities of Cooperation

The Parties agree that the actions of cooperation which are referred to in the present Agreement shall be carried out through the following modalities:

- a) exchange of significant economic data;
- b) collaboration in the search of partners and in the execution of joined promotional initiatives, as well as expositions, with the purpose to strengthen projects already determined;
- c) business participation and promotion of respective cities in fairs, expositions and conferences in both cities;
- d) cooperation between public and private companies;
- e) mutual comprehension and support, based on either city's available cultural resources, of tours, music performances, co-productions, and other artistic programs;
- f) joint collaboration between universities and research centers, and
- g) any other modalities that the Parties may agree upon.

ARTICLE IV

Competence

The Parties commit themselves to carry out the modalities of cooperation, referred to in Article III of the present Agreement, in accordance to their respective faculties, subject to the political and economical laws and regulations of their respective Governments.

ARTICLE V

Annual Action Programs

In order to achieve the objectives of the present Agreement, the Parties agree to formulate, through prior discussion, Annual Action Programs (AAP's), which shall become an integral part of the present Agreement once they are formalized.

The AAP's shall be integrated with specific projects or activities, which must reference each of the following aspects:

- a) objectives and activities to develop;
- b) work agenda;
- c) profile, quantity and duration of the assigned personnel to objectives and activities;
- d) responsibility of each Party;
- e) assignment of materials, personnel and financial resources;
- f) evaluation mechanism and criteria, and
- g) any other appropriate information.

The operation of this Agreement shall not be conditioned to the signing Parties to establish projects in all the modalities of cooperation, nor are they obligated to collaborate in those activities where internal prohibitions exists or derived by law, institutional normatives, or customs.

The Parties shall meet annually in order to evaluate the results derived from the present Agreement and to propose new guidelines for the development of projects of mutual interest.

The Parties shall produce progress reports of achievements based on the present Agreement and shall communicate them to their respective Chancellery, as well as the bilateral departments determined by mutual agreement.

Both Parties agree to formulate the first Action Program within sixty (60) days after the signing date of the present Agreement.

ARTICLE VI

Collaboration of Additional Proposals

Notwithstanding the Annual Action Program referred to in Article V of the present Agreement, each Party may formulate additional proposals, as they may arise during the implementation of activities predetermined through the AAP.

ARTICLE VII

Coordination and Follow-Up Mechanism

In order to establish a mechanism and criteria for the coordination, supervision and evaluation of the activities carried out under the present Agreement, as well as to assure the best conditions for its execution, a Working Group, integrated by representatives of both Parties, shall be established, and coordinating each parties activities the following areas:

On behalf of the City of _____ (*name of the Mexican City*), of the State of _____ (*name of the Mexican State*) of the United Mexican States, is designated the (name of the city's office in charge of the Sister City's Program);

The Working Group shall meet periodically in a location agreed upon by the Parties, in order to evaluate the activities derived from the application of the present Agreement. The Working Group shall have the following functions:

- a) Make the necessary decisions in order to carry out the objectives of the present Agreement;
- b) identify the areas of common interest in order to elaborate and formulate specific projects;
- c) orientate, organize and formulate relevant recommendations in order to fulfill the activities of the present Agreement;
- d) receive, examine and approve the progress reports in the areas of cooperation within the present Agreement, and
- e) any other functions that the Parties may agree upon.

ARTICLE VIII

Financing

The Parties shall finance the activities referred to in the present Agreement with the assigned resources in their respective budgets according to the availability and terms of their legislation. Each Party shall pay the expenses related to its participation, except in the case that alternate financial mechanisms may be used for specific activities, if considered appropriate.

ARTICLE IX

Information, Material and Protected Equipment

The Parties agree that information, material and protected equipment deemed classified by national legislation for national security or foreign relation purposes of either Party, shall not be subject to transfer within the present Agreement.

When undertaking activities pursuant to this Agreement, any information, material and equipment which require or could require protection and classification is identified, the Parties shall inform the adequate authorities and establish in writing, the corresponding measures.

The transference of information, material and equipment, which is not protected or classified, but which exportation is regulated by one of the Parties, shall be done according to the applicable national legislation and should be identified, along with its intended use or subsequent transference. If any of the Parties consider it necessary, measures shall be taken to prevent the non-authorized transference or re-transference of such property.

ARTICLE X

International Instruments

The cooperation referred to in the present Agreement shall not affect the rights and duties which the Parties have acquired regarding other international instruments.

ARTICLE XI

Intellectual Property

If as a result of actions carried out in accordance with this Agreement, products of commercial value and/or rights of intellectual property are generated, these shall be determined by the applicable national legislation, as well as the International Conventions, which are binding for both Parties.

ARTICLE XII

Employment Relationship

The personnel assigned by each Party for the execution of activities derived from the present Agreement, shall continue under the direction and dependence of the institution to which he/she pertains, and shall not create any labor relation with the other Party, which in no case shall be considered as a substitute employer.

The Parties shall carry out the necessary procedures under their respective authorities in order to facilitate the entry and departure of participants who are officially involved in the projects derived from the present Agreement. Such participants shall be subject to the immigration, tax, customs, sanitary and national security laws of the receiving country and may not partake in any activity other than those pertaining to their functions, without the previous authorization of the competent authorities in this field.

The Parties shall encourage that the personnel involved in such activities have medical, personal damage and life insurance, so that, if a damage results from such activities derived from the present Agreement, repair or indemnification shall be covered by the corresponding insurance company.

ARTICLE XIII

Disputes Settlement

Any difference or divergence derived from the interpretation or application of the present Instrument shall be resolved by both Parties in common agreement.

ARTICLE XIV

Final Provisions

The present Agreement shall go into effect upon the date of its signature and shall remain in effect for up to a five (5) year period, and may be renewed for equal periods, by evaluation and acceptance by both Parties through written communication.

The present Agreement may be modified by mutual consent of the Parties, by formalizing it through written communications and specifying the date of its enforcement.

Either of the Parties may, at any moment, terminate the present Agreement by a written notification given to the other Party sixty (60) days in advance.

The anticipated termination of the present Agreement shall not affect the completion of the activities, formalized while it was in force.

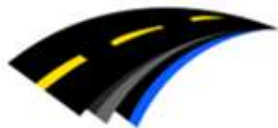

Background

The City of College Place's (City) Well No. 8 (previously referred to as Well No. 7) was drilled to a depth of 800 feet in 2024 by Gregory Drilling, Inc., and was anticipated to yield more than 1,000 gallons per minute (gpm). During well yield testing in January 2025, the well was found to only produce approximately 125 gpm with a significant drawdown to the depth of the pump intake at 450 feet. Well development activities to clear the sediment and drilling mud located in the well were beyond the capabilities of the well drilling contractor (Gregory Drilling, Inc.).

The City authorized RH2 Engineering, Inc., (RH2) in February 2025 to subcontract with specialty well development providers to clear the sediment from the well, test the developed well, and obtain a post-development well video to confirm the well's condition. This initial well development work took place in March and April 2025. Subsequent video inspection indicates that the well screen is not as obstructed as it was before this development effort, and the well is now estimated to produce approximately 500 gpm. Additional sediment and drilling mud remain in the well, but RH2 hydrogeologists and hydrogeologist subconsultant Shannon & Wilson, Inc., opine that further development can clear more of the remaining obstructions and may increase the well yield. The City requested that RH2 subcontract with the same specialty well development provider that performed the March and April 2025 development effort to perform a second effort to clear sediment from the well, test the developed well, and obtain a post-development well video to establish the well's updated condition.

General Assumptions

- *Based on video review of remaining obstructions, RH2 and its hydrogeologist subconsultant Shannon & Wilson, Inc., estimate the probability of this second well development attempt to achieve a yield of at least 700 gpm is 50 to 75 percent, though the RH2 team makes no guarantees as to the actual increase in yield.*
- *RH2 will rely upon the accuracy and completeness of information, data, and materials generated or produced by the City or others in relation to this Scope of Work.*
- *The services described herein will be performed to the level of effort identified in the attached Fee Estimate. If additional effort is needed, that extra work will be mutually determined by the City and RH2.*
- *Meetings will be held via videoconference unless otherwise noted.*
- *Deliverables will be submitted in electronic format (PDF) unless otherwise noted.*

Task 14 – Additional Well Development (May 2025)

Objective: Subcontract with the specialty well development provider to attempt to clear additional loose fine sediment observed in an April 2025 video inspection of Well No. 8.

Approach:

14.1 Coordinate with Holt Drilling, Inc., (Holt) as a subconsultant to RH2 to perform additional field work to clear loose fine sediment at Well No. 8, including well testing and video inspection following additional well development activities. Observe development activities and well performance, and summarize the activities and analysis in a technical memorandum. Include the results in the source approval report included within the original contract.

Assumptions:

- *RH2 is not responsible for site safety, or for determining means and methods or directing the contractor in their work.*
- *Up to seventy (70) hours of Holt's well development activities are included in this Scope of Work. If additional development work is necessary, an amendment may need to be negotiated between the City and RH2.*

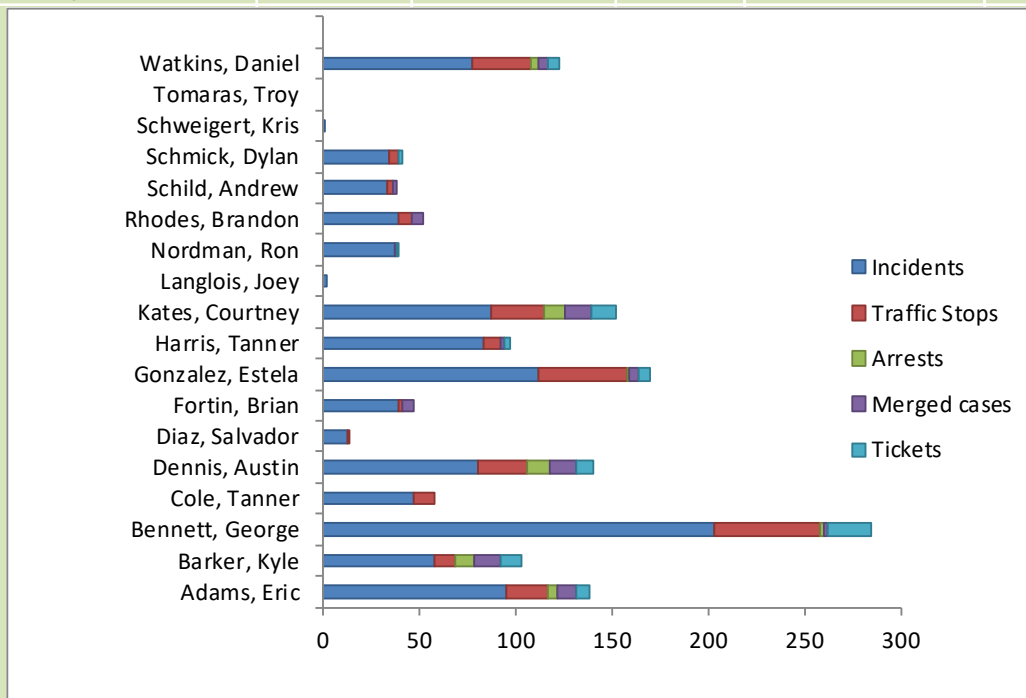
