Discussion ensued.

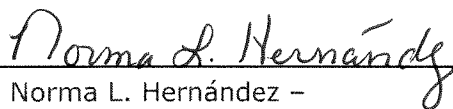
**Discussion, Information: 2.03 COVID-19 Reimbursement Tracker -**
