Staff received a grant from the Department of Archeology and Historic Preservation (DAHP) create a self guided "This Building has History" walking tour of historic properties in College Place based on the 2019 College Place Intensive & Reconnaissance Level Survey funded by DHAP.

The next phase of the project is to install "This Building Has History" signs in front of historic properties that would have a Quick Response code (QR code) that will directly link the tourist to a story map about the property and then guide them to the next historic property included in the tour.

The goal is to educate the public about architectural styles and buildings of historical significance. Prior to installing the signs, the city intends to notify the property owners in advance of installation of the signs in the right-of-way in front of each building and attempt to work with the property owner of the most suitable location. In 2022 the city was awarded a Historic Cemetery Grant to install a granite monument sign at the County Poor Farm Cemetery. Walla Walla 2020 has already done an extensive amount of research and developed a list of those buried at the site. Walla Walla County Burial Records indicate that approximately 700 people may be buried in the cemetery. My hope is that one or two the Historic Preservation Commissioners would be willing to take the lead on researching the burial records to make sure that we capture and honor all those who are buried at the cemetery, decipher name spellings, and records of birth/death if known and also provide guidance on the design of the granite monument.

Staff will contact monument companies in the region for estimates and conceptual design.

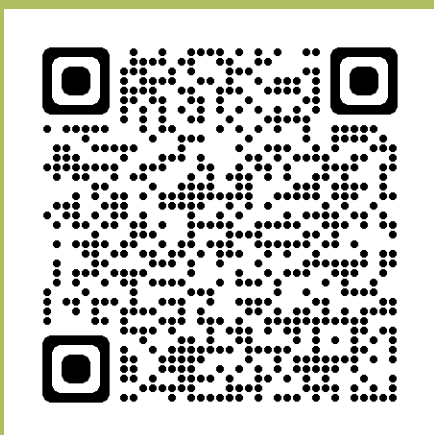

POOR FARM CEMETERY

The Walla Walla County Poor Farm Cemetery was established here in 1891. Deceased Poor Farm residents along with unclaimed remains from the Walla Walla County Coroner’s office were buried here in rows running north to south. Most graves were marked with small concrete cylinders bearing only a number. Upright markers were later placed on several of the graves by family members. Family and friends were able to find the names and location of the graves of persons buried here by consulting records maintained at the county courthouse, which have recently been discovered. After the Poor Farm closed and as the

adjoining land was being developed the larger markers were removed, the concrete cylinders were covered with soil, grass was planted over them, and playground equipment was installed on top of the graves, footings for which are still visible. The cemetery is currently owned by the City of College Place, and is protected from disturbance by Washington’s Historic Cemeteries and Graves Act. Photos of the Poor Farm house which still stands nearby on Scenic View Drive and several of the grave markers are shown below, along with names of those buried here.
